**Mama's Cooking**

It's "tween time" again! We need something to shock our winter-tired taste buds, but while spring is here garden-fresh produce won't come for weeks, yet. This is a recipe our friend Doreen shared with my family and it's a hit. Especially with grilled meats. So fire up the grill and bring out ...

**Doreen's Slaw.**

- 1 head cabbage/ cut chunky
- 2 onions/ thin sliced or chopped
- 2 green bell peppers/ thin sliced or chopped
- 1 red bell pepper/ this sliced or chopped
- 2 diced jalapeno peppers
- (opt) 1 can crushed pineapple

Layer vegetables as ordered

Boil:

- 3/4 cup oil
- 3/4 cider vinegar
- 1 1/4 tsp salt
- 1 tsp celery seed
- 1 c. sugar
- pinch of cayenne pepper

Pour over vegetables and chill
